Please nurture these values,” Sophia added.

Head of OJK North Sumatera Province Khoirul Muttaqien and Rector Secretary of Universitas Sumatera Utara Muhammad Fidel Ganis Siregar attended the event. In Camp was also attended by more than 1,000 universities’ civitas academica and representatives of both state and private schools in Medan.
